UNIT 78 DOES MORE THAN HOLD MEETINGS!

Each year the ALA Department of Washington asks each ALA Unit to compile a report of their activity for the year from May 1 to April 30. Here is a summary of this year's report for Unit 78.

*Donations to Veterans organizations: A total of \$2050 was sent to Sweats for Vets, Retsil and Orting Gift Shops, American Lake and Seattle VAMCs, Fisher Houses at JBLM and Seattle, USOs at SeaTac and JBLM Lounges, and Wounded Warriors at JBLM. *Nearly 600 Poppies were distributed in letters to members and Saar's Market over Memorial Day Weekend which raised a little over \$2,300.

*Assisted with ordering and packing as well as providing hand-crafted holiday cards for over 400 sets of sweats for Post 78's Sweats for Vets Drive.

*Helped with the Veteran's Breakfast, flag disposal ceremonies, monthly dinners, and the garage sale. *Individually, members contributed over 600 hours of time and \$5,000 of donations to community organizations.
