POST MEMBERSHIP

The Post currently stands at 83.55% of goal for our current Legion year 2024. There are still about 40 members that are delinquent in paying 2024 dues.

National Headquarters has notified the Posts that the National per capita will go up \$5 on July 1^{st} . By Post bylaws, this increase must be passed on to our members, therefore Post dues for 2025 will be \$55.

There is a way for members to forestall this increase by paying their 2025,2026 and 2027 dues earlier with one payment online for a total of \$150. Sorry, National is not offering a discount for three years.
